We are moving full speed ahead with a fishing pier on the river at the back of our Park (in co-operation with the NC Wildlife Commission) and close to it, with a kayak and canoe launch, that's being made possible by a generous donor and the Town.





HISTORY CORNER

One of my memories of my early years at Mills River was attending the annual Gillespie-Sitton reunion at the home of my great uncle, Henry Gillespie (1882-1948). The family cooks always contributed to the creation of a bountiful buffet on the front porch. I have two group photographs taken at a reunion around 1940. One includes only the women and girls, including my maternal grandmother, Minnie Sitton Gillespie (1879-1965). The second photo shows the men and boys. It included Uncle Henry and his older brother, George Gillespie (1870-1954). Several of the younger men in the picture were destined to see military service during World War II.



I also have a much older picture taken at a reunion held at the same house around 1918. It was a smaller gathering with the men, women, and children all in the same photograph. My grandfather, John Gillespie (1873-1928), is standing in the back row beside Minnie and their oldest son, Albert. Uncle Henry's sister, Sarah Jane (Jenny) Gillespie Field and her husband, Will Field (1861-1938), are also shown standing between George and Henry. My great grandmother, Mary Orr Gillespie (1847-1926) and her brother, Perry Orr (1849-1928), were among those seated in the second row. Perry was a music teacher and composer. His compositions included the Mills River Waltz and "Band Box" that were in my brother Jere Brittain's CD, released in 2004.

Uncle Henry acquired ownership of considerable acreage of mountain and river bottom land by the early 1920s. He lived alone after his mother's death in 1926. He obtained water and cooled dairy products in an enclosed spring near the house. I still remember the cold spring water as quite refreshing on a hot summer day. He grew corn on his fertile river bottom. He used his own seed corn to produce a large single ear on a very tall stalk. He stocked trout in a small pond in his creek. He owned a Model T Ford and continued to drive it long after most of his neighbors had changed to more modern vehicles.

I visited Uncle Henry several times during the 1940s. I enjoyed listening to his stories, and recall being fascinated by his large rotary grindstone driven by a foot treadle. He used it to sharpen a variety of blades. On one visit, I brought my camera and persuaded him to pose for a close up photograph. He was wearing his bib overalls at the time and I still have the black and white photo. He was buried in the family cemetery near his home. The house where our reunions were held on longer exists.

ADVERTISEMENT OF TAX LIENS ON REAL PROPERTY FOR THE YEAR 2014

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Tax Collector by § 105-369 of the North Carolina General Statutes, and pursuant to an Order by the Mills River Town Council, the Tax Collector is hereby advertising liens for the year 2014 on the real estate described below. The amount advertised will be increased by interest and advertisement costs, and the omission of interest and advertisement costs from the amount advertised will not constitute a waiver of the taxing unit's claim for those items.

North Carolina General Statute § 105-369 requires that tax liens be advertised in the name of the owner as of the date of delinquency. The date of delinquency for the 2014 tax year was January 6, 2015.

If these taxes remain unpaid, the Town of Mills River may foreclose and sell the property to satisfy all claims of unpaid taxes.

<u>Do not mail</u> the principal amount of taxes due. Please contact the Mills River Tax Collector for the correct amount owed including interest and penalties.

As you may have already noticed, the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission has constructed a handicapped accessible fishing pier (platform) on the river at the north end of our park. There is a concrete walkway connecting our existing paved path to the pier for access right now. Parking for this facility is currently available at the main lot at Town Hall until the canoe/kayak launch facility is built in the same vicinity. There are plans for a parking area to be constructed in conjunction with the launch. Access to that parking area, when completed, will be directly off of Hooper Lane. We are hopeful that construction will begin soon.



Graduates and current participants in the Rising Leaders Program in conjunction with United Way of Henderson County, installed the Born Learning Trail this past October. This trail is a valuable community resource to help young children boost language, reading, problem solving and critical thinking skills. The Born Learning Trail is a series of 10 signs and activities that are posted around the front walking trail with the purpose of promoting learning in a fun and interactive way. Mills River is proud to have the first Born Learning Trail in Henderson County. On Tuesday April 14th at 4:00 pm, there will be a ribbon cutting event to officially "open" the trail. We hope everyone can find the time to come out and show their support.

RECIPE CORNER

Not Yo' Mama's Banana Pudding

2 bags Pepperidge Farm Chessmen cookies 6-8 bananas, sliced

- 2 cups milk
- 1 (5 ounce) box instant French vanilla pudding
- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 (12 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- ★ Line bottom of 13" x 9" x 2" dish with 1 bag of cookies and layer bananas on top.
- ★ In a bowl, combine the milk and pudding mix, blending well using a hand held electric mixer.
- ★ Using another bowl, combine the cream cheese and condensed milk together and mix until smooth.
- ★ Fold the whipped topping into the cream cheese mixture.
- ★ Add the cream cheese mixture to the pudding mixture and stir until blended well.
- ★ Pour the mixture over cookies and bananas and cover with remaining cookies.
- ★ Refrigerate until ready to serve.

Prescription drug abuse is a problem that is growing nationwide. Even here in Henderson County and Mills River, it is a growing problem. People from all walks can become victims to prescription drug abuse.

Approximately 90% of all unintentional poisoning deaths were drug/medication-related overdose deaths in Henderson County. Prescription drug abuse is also linked to many different crimes.

In Henderson County, about 80-85% of all crimes are linked to substance abuse. Hope RX is an organization that has many resources to help people with prescription drug abuse. For further information you can visit their website at http://hope-rx.org/.

The Henderson County Sheriff's Office periodically conducts pill drops throughout the year to collect unneeded and unwanted medications. There is also a permanent collection box for unused medications available to the public, Monday-Friday, 8am to 5pm. The collection box is located in the front lobby of the Henderson County Sheriff's office located at 100 North Grove St in Hendersonville. Please keep in mind that they do not accept sharps/needles or chemotherapy drugs.
